3 Days - 2 Nights

A dynamic residential designed to develop pupils confidence and communication skills to cope with new situations, ideal for facilitating transition to secondary school. Students develop a range of woodland knowledge as they work together on challenges, getting to know each other.

They build their own resilience, as they solve problems and learn new primitive skills.

Typical programme:

Day 1

- Camouflage and conceal
- Woodland orienteering

- Cooking on real fires
- Wilderness first aid

- Bat walk and marshmallow roasting

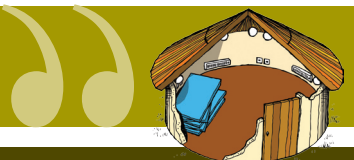
Day 2: Boudicca's Warriors
